
FINAL ORDER

On July 30, 2019, the Virginia State Bar Disciplinary Board (“Virginia State Bar”) entered an order permanently revoking Jerry Mack Douglas, Jr.’s license to practice law in the Commonwealth of Virginia on consent. *In re Jerry Mack Douglas, Jr.*, VSB Docket No. 19-000-114086 (July 30, 2019).

Mr. Douglas has been a member of this Court’s bar since August 21, 1997. Under Rule 83.2(c)(3) of the Rules of the United States Court of Federal Claims (“RCFC”), an attorney admitted to practice before this Court may be disciplined on the grounds of his or her disbarment on consent or resignation from the bar of another court while an investigation into an allegation of misconduct is pending. Reciprocal disbarment is the presumed discipline for an attorney’s disbarment on consent or resignation from the bar of another court during a misconduct investigation. RCFC 83.2(g)(7)(C). Mr. Douglas also failed to notify this Court of his disbarment, which is a violation of RCFC 83.2(e)(1)(C) and additional grounds for discipline under RCFC 83.2(c)(4).

On September 6, 2019, the Court issued an order directing Mr. Douglas to show cause within thirty (30) days why the Court should not impose discipline equivalent to that imposed by the Virginia State Bar. ECF No. 4. The order to show cause further stated that if no response was received, Mr. Douglas would be permanently disbarred from practice before the United States Court of Federal Claims. *Id.* To date, Mr. Douglas has not responded to the Order to Show Cause. Therefore,


IT IS ORDERED that Jerry Mack Douglas, Jr. shall be permanently disbarred from the practice of law before the United States Court of Federal Claims, effective, *nunc pro tunc*, July 30, 2019, the date of his disbarment by the Virginia State Bar. *See* RCFC 83.2(h)(4). The filing of any petition for reinstatement will be governed by RCFC 83.2(k)(1).
