

Petitioners' Steering Committee Statement re "Series of Injuries" in Woods v. Sec'ty of the Dept. of Health and Human Services.

The Petitioners' Steering Committee ("PSC") was asked by Mr. Kenneth W. Jones of the Kenneth W. Jones Law Offices to discuss the legal issues raised by the Special Master Hastings' Order of February 6, 2003 in Woods v. Sec'ty of the Dept. of Health and Human Services, No. 02-1317V. Mr. Jones and the PSC specifically discussed whether the PSC would submit a legal brief as part of petitioner Woods' response to respondent's dismissal brief regarding the "series of injuries" issue raised by the Special Master in his February 6, 2003 Order. The Special Master was advised that the PSC was considering the issue and that a brief would be forthcoming.

Page 1 - PSC STATEMENT RE "SERIES OF INJURIES"

Based on extensive discussions with Mr. Jones, and a review of the file in Woods, the

PSC respectfully declines to submit a legal brief on this issue at this time. The questions posed

by the "series of injuries" theory are ones of fact, not of law, and present issues of general

causation at the very heart of the Omnibus Proceeding. The PSC believes that the questions

raised by the Special Master can only be addressed by the various scientific and medical experts

after appropriate opportunity to review and analyze the scientific data, including that sought

through the Omnibus discovery process.

The PSC suspects that there will be much debate at the time of the Omnibus causation

hearings that will specifically address whether or not children repeatedly exposed to

ethylmercury in receipt of serial vaccines sustained new, additional, or continuing injuries with

each exposure, and whether the serial vaccines constituted significant aggravations of any

injuries. Such testimony must be left to the realm of the experts and not to the PSC's

speculation, and is therefore not amenable to a general legal brief at this time.
