ORDER

After discussion at the status conference held on April 25, 2007, upon the motion of Mr. Powers of the Petitioners' Steering Committee ("PSC"), we hereby adjust the procedures for service of documents in the Omnibus Autism Proceeding as follows.


Effective immediately, the respondent will no longer need to serve a copy of documents filed into the Autism Master File upon "Liaison Counsel" Ghada Anis. Instead, respondent shall serve such documents upon the following two representatives of the PSC, at the following addresses:



Also, the Clerk of this court is hereby instructed not to send copies of the court's Autism Master File filings to Ms. Anis. Instead, such documents shall be sent to the same two counsel noted above.


